Heritage Le Château is one of the architectural wonders of Mauritius. Commissioned by the Indian notable Hajee Jackaria Hajee Ahmed, this jewel was raised in the 19th century on an island then part of the British Empire. The Château still keeps a precise memory from this era, and is now a testimony to history. This building has passed through times without losing of its unique British-Indian elegance. Faithful to this rich past, Heritage Le Château has been restored and the gardens refurbished in 2017.


